- \* Food security and political stability
- \* Food dynamics of istanbul
- \* Gentrification and culinary power, gentrification on Istanbul's culinary landscape and the displacement of certain communities

### Submission Guidelines

Abstract Submission: Submit a 300-500 words abstract outlining the research question, methodology, and key findings.

Abstract Review Process: All applications will be evaluated by the Sapor Istanbul Selective Board, a.k.a Sapor Knights.

Submission Format: Presented below.

- \*The papers must be unpublished and not previously submitted or presented.
- \*Selected papers will have the opportunity to be presented at the symposium and they will be included in the proceedings book.
- \*Full Paper Format: Submissions must follow the symposium paper template that will be provided after the acceptance mail. Full papers should be between 5,000 and 7,000 words, including references.
